



Your pharmacy benefits

Tier	Copay/coinsurance
Tier 1: Generics	Member pays a \$15 copay or the full cost of the medication, whichever is less.
Tier 2 & 3: Preferred and nonpreferred brands	Member pays 100% of the cost of the drug at the point of sale and files for 80% reimbursement subject to the \$200 deductible.*
Tier 4: Certain high-cost specialty drugs and brand-name diabetic drugs	Members are responsible for 20% coinsurance at the point of sale. The plan covers medications at 80%. All insulin and insulin combination products have a maximum \$100 member cost share per 30-day supply filled.
Specialty medications	Filled through designated specialty pharmacies, specialty medications can be found in multiple tiers and follow the benefit structure of that tier.
